1.0 SPORT: RUGBY- SEVENS

- 1.2 Competition Dates: July 26-29, 2020
- 1.3 Sanction: Yes, Saskatchewan Rugby

3.0 CLASSIFICATIONS:

- 3.1 Year of Birth: Athletes born in 2003 through 2005

4.0 ELIGIBILITY:

- 4.1 Athletes: Birth year 2003, 2004, 2005. All athletes must abide by the residency criteria and regulations outlined in the Saskatchewan Games Handbook. Must be registered with Saskatchewan Rugby
- 4.2 Coaches: Coaches must complete World Rugby Level One.

As a coach or manager of a district team you will be volunteering with children, who are vulnerable members of our society. As per the policy of the Saskatchewan Games Council all coaches and managers are required to undergo a Criminal Record Check and a Vulnerable Sector Check.

As per the mandatory requirements for all sports in Saskatchewan the "Respect In Sport" online training program must be taken by all coaches. It is strongly recommended that managers take the online training to ensure that as youth leaders they recognize, understand and respond to issues of abuse, bullying and harassment.

8.2 Sport Scoring:

Win = 4 points
Draw = 2 points
Loss = 0 points
Win by Default = 5 points
Bonus points awarded:
4 tries or more in a game = 1 point
Loss by 7 points or less = 1 point

9.0 TIE BREAKING PROCEDURE:

- 1) Most wins
- 2) Record of the games played between the two teams
- 3) The team with the highest total points scored in the games between the two teams that are tied.
- 4) The most bonus points earned in pool play
- 5) The score differential, points for minus points against in pool play

10.0 SPORT PROTEST PROCEDURE:

As per Sask Rugby Discipline Procedure found at www.saskrugby.com/discipline.

11.0 EQUIPMENT:

As per World Rugby Laws of the Game #1 & #2 . Field length will be 94 meters minimum and 100 meters maximum. Field width will be 68 meters minimum and 70 meters maximum. In-goal length will be 6 meters minimum and 22 meters maximum. Post pads and field flags are required. Game ball will be a Gilbert Size 5.

12.0 SPORT JURY: will consist of the Provincial Technical Liaison, Sport Chair and the Head Official. The committee will decide on an appropriate sanction for the player via a majority vote. The committee will follow the guidelines set out in the World Rugby Regulation 17 for Discipline for Foul Play.

13.0 OFFICIALS REQUIRED:

13.1 Major Officials: Minimum of 12 officials

13.2 Minor Officials: scoreboard, ball chasers etc.

14.0 MEDICAL SERVICES: Require 2 therapists for each game – one for each team.
