Community Rugby Development

Registration (SportLomo)

Rugby Canada manages a national registration platform which provides peace of mind that all personal information required for participants to register is protected on one integrated platform across all levels of Rugby in Canada. The registration minimizes the risk of financial risk by removing the physical handling of money at all levels, reducing the risk of financial abuse. The platforms also allow stakeholders to provide accurate reports on participation for funding partners and other stakeholders.

National Insurance Program

Rugby Canada manages a National Insurance Program that provides coverage across a combination of 4 policies to ensure that Rugby in Canada is played safely, and should an accident happen, Rugby Canada staff manage the claim process. Rugby Canada manages the General Liability Policy, Accidental Death and Dismemberment Policy, Travel Medical Policy, Directors and Officers Policy. Rugby Canada and its members share the financial responsibility of any claims with an insurance reserve to cover the cost of the claim's deductible.

International Player Clearance

Rugby Canada manages the clearance process for a player, in accordance with World Rugby Regulation 4, to move to another country. Players (both youth and adult) are required to obtain international clearance from Rugby Canada in order to play rugby for a club in another Union. This clearance is an assurance that players do not leave the country with any disciplinary issues, or financial commitments to previous rugby clubs.



Tour Sanctioning

Rugby Canada manages the tour sanctioning process (both club and school), which requires a permission to tour for teams to travel outbound, from Canada to another country. Countries will not sanction a rugby activity without permission to tour from the home union. Rugby Canada also manages the process for teams who wish to visit Canada by ensuring that permission to tour has been granted from the home union. This permission to tour is an assurance that relevant coverage is in place for all traveling participants, and that the tour parties are in good standing order.

Community Rugby Development Officers

Rugby Canada is committed to supporting the growth and development of Rugby in Canada by investing in jointly funded Rugby Development Officers and sessional coaches. These jointly funded positions are partnerships with Provincial Unions to focus on delivery of rugby programs that support club and school growth and development.

Training & Education

Rugby Canada provides the content and resources for all formal National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP) courses, match officiating, medical, strength and conditioning. Rugby Canada utilizes World Rugby resources and adapts the resources for the Canadian context. Rugby Canada also provides the training for all educators and learning facilitators across Canada to deliver all formal NCCP courses, match officiating, medical, strength and conditioning. Rugby Canada also manages the Master Trainer/Developer workforce to quality assurance the delivery of training and education across Canada. Rugby Canada also offers access to online webinars and professional development opportunities around national team events.

Rugby Canada PlaySmart & SafeSport

Rugby Canada PlaySmart is a player welfare program that aims to educate players, parents, coaches, match officials and administrators on the safety of rugby across Canada. Rugby Canada provides minimum standards to participate in Rugby in Canada, as well as resources that provide guidance on how best to create a safe, inclusive, and welcoming environment for all participants. Rugby Canada PlaySmart includes, but not limited to, education resources, guidelines, programs, and policies including SafeSport.

Rugby Canada Rookie Rugby

Rugby Canada provides resources, which are Physical Health Education Canada approved, that Rugby Clubs, Schools and Communities can use to introduce rugby in a safe and inclusive way to new participants. Rugby Canada also offers high quality Rookie Rugby equipment which assists any stakeholder in sourcing the necessary equipment to start a Rugby program. The resources available include training, coaching/festival resources, video content all online.
